MONA – The Museum of Old and New Art

MONA is the perfect day trip and partner activity. Travelling to MONA on board the MR1 Mona Ferry, departing from Brooke St Pier Hobart, cruise up the Derwent River for half an hour before arriving on the doorstep of the largest private art collection in the Southern Hemisphere. Spend the day submerged in David Walsh's 'Adult Disneyland'. Onsite there is a restaurant, café, wine bar and cellar door, all providing a fantastic interlude from the gallery.

Tasmanian Museum and Art Gallery

Located on Hobart's historic waterfront, the Tasmanian Museum and Art Gallery (TMAG) has recently undergone a spectacular \$30 million redevelopment. The second oldest museum in Australia, TMAG has its origins in the collections of the country's oldest scientific society, the Royal Society of Tasmania, which was established in 1843. Visitors can now experience more of the museum's unique site than ever before, including a fascinating range of nationally significant archaeological material, some of which has been hidden for over 150 years.

Shene Tasmania Historic Tours


Located at Pontville, just 30 minutes north of Hobart; ignite your passion for Tasmania's colonial past and Australian history with an escorted tour of the Shene Historic Site. Guided by a Shene custodian the tour includes exclusive access to the country estate, including the properties homestead, stables, barn, dairy and the Estate's outbuildings.

Cascade Brewery

Australia's oldest continuously operating brewery. The brewery is located in the foothills of Mount Wellington, five minutes' drive from Hobart's central business district. Cascade Brewery produces a range of fine Tasmanian beers and soft drinks. You can take a two hour brewery tour to see all aspects of the beer making process.

Lark Distillery

Lark Distillery was the first licensed distillery in Tasmania since 1839. It was established in 1992 to produce Australian malt whiskey, rich in character with a big finish using Tasmanian ingredients. Join the Lark team at the cellar door, located on the Hobart waterfront for an exploration of the world of single malt whiskey or enter a world of peat smoke and passion on a whiskey tour.



Port Arthur Historic Site

The Port Arthur experience is unforgettable. Just a one and half hour drive from Hobart, a visit to Port Arthur Historic Site is Tasmania's iconic cultural heritage experience. The Port Arthur Historic Site has more than 30 buildings, ruins, and restored period homes dating from the prisons establishment in 1830 until its closure in 1877. During this time around 12,500 convicts served sentences. Onsite visitors can experience guided walks, harbour cruises, access to the museum and the interpretation gallery and for those brave enough they can visit the Isle of the Dead or join the evening Ghost Tour.

Tasman Island Cruises

Tasman Island Cruises provides unforgettable three hour wilderness cruises along the spectacular coastline between Port Arthur and Eaglehawk Neck. The Cruise travels beneath the highest vertical sea cliffs in the Southern Hemisphere and guests can explore waterfalls, rock formations archways and deep sea caves.

Barilla Bay Oyster Farm

Barilla Bay Oysters are grown and harvested in Australia's premium shellfish growing environment and the delicate taste and texture of Barilla Bay Oysters reflect the natural quality of the water in which they are grown. Located only 5 minutes away from the Hobart airport, and on the way to the Tasman Peninsula, enjoy a personalised Oyster Farm Tour and delicious lunch at Barilla Bay.

Peppermint Bay

Enjoy a relaxing, rejuvenating and rewarding day on board the luxurious 23 metre catamaran Peppermint Bay II, departing from Brooke St Pier in Hobart the cruise takes in harbour and city views, the Derwent river and its magnificent estuary whilst cruising along the D'Entrecasteaux Channel to Peppermint Bay. Enjoy a delicious lunch, spectacular scenery and world class wines before cruising back to Hobart.

Tahune Airwalk

Walk through the three storeys high canopy of a Tasmanian wet forest – home to amazing flora, including Eucalyptus Regnans – the world's tallest flowering plant. The Tahune Airwalk extends for 597 metres, taking you on an amazing tour through treetops of naturally regenerated forests. Visitors can also Hang Glide, walk on swinging bridges or stay in the Airwalk Lodge.

Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary

Bonorong is not a zoo. They are a wildlife sanctuary specialising in the care and rehabilitation of orphaned and injured wildlife while giving you an up close and personal experience. Bonorong has one of the largest mobs of friendly, free ranging kangaroos and wallabies; you can meet them all by hand feeding them.

The Lady Nelson

The STV Lady Nelson is owned and operated by the Tasmanian Sail Training Association, a not-for-profit company run solely by a large number of volunteers, which allows us to easily meet your requirements. The Lady Nelson is available for charter from 15 minutes up to several weeks in duration. We are licensed to carry from 1 to 32 passengers for day trips, 1 to 10 passengers for overnight sails and up to 45 for alongside events. We can (and do!) provide Harbour sails for delegates and partners, team building exercises, transport to other places around Southern Tasmania, VIP functions, conference tours, lunches and dinners with gourmet Tasmanian food and wine, twilight drinks and even Tasmanian whiskey tasting tours!

Mawson's Hut Replica Museum

Mawson's Hut Replica Museum is located on Hobart's waterfront, a full scale replica of the historic huts used by Douglas Mawson's Australasian Antarctic Expedition 1911 – 1914. An intimate glimpse of how 18 men lived and worked in such confined conditions, providing tourists with an important link to Australia Antarctic history.
